Welcome to the first edition of our Newsletter for 2025. We have aimed to reflect on some of the festive highlights as well as looking ahead to what promises to be an exciting Spring term.

We are busy behind the scenes organising our residential experiences for our Key Stage 2 children. We are looking forward to taking our Year 6 children to London later this year. We will also be taking Year 5 to PGL again following a fantastic trip last year. Year 4 will also have the opportunity to camp in school over night with a day of beach activities to follow! We are also planning a number of trips across the next few terms to compliment the curriculum learning of each class.

Swimming lessons will begin this term. We aim to ensure that all of our KS2 children can swim competently and proficiently a minimum of at least 25 metres. Once this is achieved, children will be offered the opportunity to attend optional surf lessons in Year 5 and 6.

# Talents outside of school...






Not only do we see our children's amazing talents in school, we also love hearing about their achievements outside of school!

Teen privacy and safety settings | TikTok Help Center<sup>4</sup>

It is crucial that these settings are implemented if your child has access to these social media platforms. Some key features of Teen Accounts that distinguish them from adult accounts include:

- **Default private accounts**: Teen accounts are automatically set to private, ensuring that only approved followers can view their content.
- **Restricted messaging**: These accounts are set to receive messages only from users they follow or have previously connected with.
- **Controlled tagging and mentions**: Tags and mentions are limited to people they follow.

These are just a few of the features designed to enhance safety for younger users. We strongly encourage you to review and apply these settings to help ensure your child's safety while using social media.

# Inclusion

As we begin a new term at St Merryn we look forward to working with our children and their families. If you have any queries or questions about your child's educational development or possible needs please do not hesitate to make an appointment so that we can discuss the various options and support that might be available. We are able to 'sign post' our families to a number of services including the Early Help Hub, School Nurse and Mental Health Support team.

'In house', we can offer additional emotional coaching, support with children who have experienced trauma and individualised packages through our own forest school provision.

We also have trained autism champions which can provide additional advice/support where needed.


